# Housing, Meals, and Travel will be provided and paid for by MFU for the duration of employment.

MFU will conduct 4 weeks of 4-6 day overnight camps. As a counselor, this job would require you to arrive at camp on Sunday or Saturday afternoon and remain at camp through the following weeks for each of the four week-long camps.

MFU will conduct 5 weeks of day camps; with 3 weeks consisting of 3 days of single day camps, and 2 weeks of 3-day series day camps.

All travel to and from camps will be provided by MFU. Prior to the start of the camps, we will have two training periods. The first period of training will be all online, and the second will be in person at the office in Saint Paul. During this time, you will learn everything you need to know to become a successful camp counselor with MFU. Our camp is a coed camp and therefore we need both male and female counselors.

An MFU Camp Counselor is responsible for planning, leading, and implementing core and non-core programs and experiences for children in small and large group settings. They will also be responsible for the general safety and development, growth, and skill achievement of the participants in his/her group. The counselor will provide high quality outdoor educational and recreational experiences for participants that focus on the MFU core values of cooperation, leadership, respect and responsibility.

### **Essential Responsibilities**

- Organize and lead a variety of small and large group activities each session. Activities may include crafts, nature, songs, games, swimming, etc.
- Identify and respond to camper behavior issues.
- Ensure that each site is kept clean, organized, and free of litter.
- Communicate with parents about participant's experiences and report concerns to Camp Leadership.
- Assist in maintaining accurate program records including incident reports and daily attendance.
- Know and understand ALL emergency procedures associated with the camp program.
- Know, enforce, and follow all safety guidelines associated with the camp and all program areas. This includes but is not limited to being responsible for your campers' safety and their whereabouts at all times.

## **Qualifications - Required**

- Education classes or experience in camp, youth programs, recreation, working with children, or a related area.
- Upon hire, completion of MFU provided First Aid and CPR certification.
- Ability to lead, plan, organize, and implement program activities.

- Ability to work as a member of a team and the ability to accomplish tasks with little direct supervision.
- Strong organizational and communication skills.

### **Physical Demands - Required**

Must have the physical ability to lead and participate in camp activities which include, but are not limited to, hiking, canoeing, swimming, team building initiatives, building campfires, physical games, and activities.
