- Q1** Do you approve or disapprove of President Joe Biden's job performance?
- Approve* 43%
 - Disapprove* 48%
 - Not sure* 9%
- Q2** Generally speaking, do you think big corporations in Minnesota have too much power, not enough power, or about the right amount of power?
- Too much power* 56%
 - Not enough power* 7%
 - About the right amount of power*..... 27%
 - Not sure* 10%
- Q3** When thinking about the current problem with inflation and rising prices, how much do you blame big corporations: a lot, some, just a little, or not much at all?
- A lot*..... 38%
 - Some* 29%
 - Just a little*..... 11%
 - Not much at all*..... 19%
 - Not sure* 3%
- Q4** Would you support or oppose giving the state Attorney General's office more resources to prosecute bad corporate actors?
- Support* 59%
 - Oppose* 22%
 - Not sure* 19%
- Q5** There's a bill in the Minnesota Legislature that would reform antitrust law to make it easier to rein in abusive conduct by big corporations. Do you support or oppose this bill?
- Support* 63%
 - Oppose* 16%
 - Not sure* 20%
- Q6** There's a bill in the Minnesota Legislature that would give workers more ability to prevent large employers like Amazon from using their size and power to dominate labor markets and lower wages. Do you support or oppose this bill?
- Support* 71%
 - Oppose* 17%
 - Not sure* 12%
- Q7** There's a bill in the Minnesota Legislature that would prevent big retailers like Amazon and Walmart from using their buying power to demand lower prices from suppliers, a practice that hurts small, local retailers. Do you support or oppose this bill?
- Support* 54%
 - Oppose* 23%
 - Not sure* 24%
- Q8** If your state Legislator voted for legislation to rein in monopoly power in Minnesota, would that make you more likely or less likely to vote for them, or would it not make a difference?
- More Likely to Vote for Them* 50%
 - Less Likely to Vote for Them* 18%
 - Wouldn't make a Difference*..... 21%
 - Not Sure*..... 11%

Q13 If you are a Democrat, press 1. If a Republican, press 2. If an independent, press 3.

- Democrat* 37%
- Republican* 27%
- Independent* 36%

Q14 If you are white, press 1. If other, press 2.

- White* 87%
- Other* 13%

Q15 If you are 18-45 years old, press 1. If 46-65, press 2. If older than 65, press 3.

- 18 to 45* 37%
- 46 to 65* 40%
- Older than 65* 23%

Q16 What is the highest level of education you have received: high school graduate or less, some college but did not finish, 2-year college degree, 4-year college degree, or post-graduate degree?

- High school graduate or less* 27%
- Some college but did not finish* 19%
- 2-year college degree* 17%
- 4-year college degree* 23%
- Post-graduate degree* 13%

- Suburban area* 41%
